

Expansion Progress Updates:

St. Charles Location:

- Ongoing Enhancements: The St. Charles Campus external office building has undergone a much-needed repair and a fresh coat of paint.
- **Project Update:** Phase 2 of the project is nearing completion, and Phase 3 permits have been approved.
- Future Plans: We continue on track with project milestones, and Phase 3 construction is ready to begin with a completion date of Fall 2025.

Little Creek Location:

- Advanced Production Equipment: The installation of state-of-the-art production equipment has been completed, elevating our capabilities to deliver top-notch productions and enhancing service experience online and in person.
- Worship Center Improvements: We have replaced all lights in the worship center significantly enhancing our TV and broadcast quality across all campuses.

West Esplanade Location:

- Early Learning Center: We are excited to announce that progress continues unabated toward the opening of our Early Learning Center (ELC). Preparations are underway, pending state permits and licensing.
- Global Impact: The West Esplanade campus led a successful mission trip to Mexico City, Mexico, where the team provided vital services to the local community. Over the course of the mission trip, they served 413 medical patients, offered haircuts and nail care to 139 individuals, and engaged with 139 children through various activities. Remarkably, 196 people made decisions of faith during the trip.

Baton Rouge Location:

• **COTK Kids Remodel:** The drawings have been approved by the city, and construction has begun! The target completion date is January 1st.

Biloxi Location:

- Phase 1: Phase 1 of our KB Church Expansion Campaign has begun.
- **Design Milestone:** The drawings of our new schematics are complete, reflecting our commitment to modern and efficient design.
- Pricing Phase: Pricing is confirmed, & construction will begin as project becomes funded.

Bay St. Louis Location:

- Phase 1: Phase 1 of our KB Church Expansion Campaign has begun.
- **Design Milestone:** The drawings of our new schematics are in process, with the primary elements of the design completed.
- Pricing Phase: Pricing is confirmed, and construction will begin as the project becomes funded.

Church Online:

- Exciting Growth: We are on track to double our average weekend attendance in 2024 over 2023, with an average weekend attendance of 21,139 people.
- Global Reach: We are expanding in the U.S. and abroad with new volunteers serving in places like Utah, Iowa, Indiana, Florida, and Texas, as well as internationally in Uganda, England, Honduras, Pakistan, and more!
- **Uganda Small Group:** Our first small group in Uganda launched this fall, with 15 people going through Pastor Randy's Foundations curriculum!

Cape Town Location:

- Interest Meeting: Our Most recent interest meeting in October had 119 people in attendance! Many have already begun the Next Steps experience.
- COTK Business Leaders Trip: A mission trip with COTK Business Leaders traveled to
 Cape Town to host a business seminar for our Cape Town business leaders and connect
 with them in small groups. Over 120 business leaders attended and were inspired to live
 lives and lead in a way that honors God and transforms communities!

Atlanta South Location:

- Student Impact: Our Atlanta South Campus has begun NextGen school clubs in their community to reach high school students for Jesus.
- Global Impact: Atlanta South lead their first Global Mission trip to Juarez, Mexico. Our team of 13 came together to construct a home for a grandmother, her son, his wife, and their new baby. Previously residing in a tent, they now enjoy the comfort of a twobedroom home equipped with air conditioning and a bathroom.



Ethiopia

• Each year we send a mission team to Ethiopia to partner with HopeEthiopia. The vision of HopEthiopia is to bring total restoration to Harbu Chulule, Ethiopia by offering practical support through education, Biblical teaching, and sustainable living. The organization provides a home and future for orphaned children and empowers widowed women as "house moms" to nurture these children. They also reforest the land, planting 250,000 trees annually, which improves air quality and strengthens the local economy. Our teams work along aside HopeEthopia to build new homes, provide daily essentials, plant trees, and expand educational facilities. Future initiatives focus on constructing permanent structures for schools, growing income-generating businesses, and supporting church leaders through discipleship and training.

Plan

First, pray and make a plan to give an amount over and above your tithe in 2024. When you have a plan and are diligent, it leads to plenty, according to Proverbs 21:5. Whatever the amount is—have a plan in place, work the plan, and be obedient with it. This is a great place to start!

Stretch
